

ECAP

An ECAP (Education and Career Action Plan) is a four year plan that reflects a student's current plan of coursework, career aspirations, and extended learning opportunities (elective courses, sports, clubs, community service) in order to develop the student's individual academic and career goals (university, community college, training, military, or work).

What are the benefits of student ECAP Plans and Process?

- ⇒ Personalized planning will help **students** reach their academic and career goals. It impacts student achievement and preparedness for successful transition into the workforce and into additional academic pursuits related to career options.
- ⇒ It provides **families** increased opportunities to be involved in their student's education.
- ⇒ It promotes increased achievement in more rigorous courses relevant to students' goals.
- ⇒ ECAP gives students "a voice and a choice" in personalizing education around their interests, their skills, and their aspirations, so that they can maximize the opportunities available to them after graduation.
